

LEAK DETECTION

How to perform an evaporation test

This test should be conducted over a 12 hour period with all equipment turned off. For best results the test should be conducted overnight as there will be less evaporation and therefore any leak will be more evident

- 1/ Bring the pool water to its normal level.
- 2/ Fill a large bucket and place on the second step of the pool. Fill the bucket with water to approximately the same level as the pool water. It may be necessary to put something heavy and non-porous (i.e. metal weight) in the bottom of the bucket to prevent it from floating away.
- 3/ Mark the water level inside the bucket.
- 4/ Mark the pool water level on the outside of the bucket, or on the pool wall or skimmer face plate.
- 5/ After 12 hours compare the two levels. If the pool water (outside mark) goes down more than the inside water level, there is probably a leak.
